Instructions for your Statement of Intent

Essays should include an explanation of your interest in MFT as a profession, and why you are interested in the DFI program specifically. Tell us how this program fits with your professional goals and who you are as a person. Essays may include but are not limited to: background and experiences with MFT, how you decided to pursue MFT, what you will bring to the program, your strengths and weaknesses as a potential MFT, and what you want out of your time at DFI.

Essay should be 2-3 pages, typed, double spaced.
